| <b>Maths:</b>    | <u>Shape Hunt</u><br>Go outside to your garden, visit a local park or simply take a walk in your neighbourhood. Bring a notepad and pencil or a camera.<br>Look out for shapes. They can be 2D or 3D shapes.<br>Record the shapes you can find.  |
| <b>Other:</b>    | <u>Art Challenge</u><br>Make a nature wind chime out of twigs, pine cones, shells etc. Hang it where it will catch the wind.   |
